About this Collection

News from the Bird Banders and its successor *Western Bird Bander* were published quarterly by the Western Bird Banding Association (WBBA) from 1926 through 1975. In 1976 WBBA joined forces with the Eastern Bird Banding Association to publish *North American Bird Bander*. The Inland Bird Banding Association joined the group in 1982.

News from the Bird Banders (v.1:1, 1926-v.36:1, 1961) was produced using a manual typewriter to create each page on a mimeograph master. The masters were then attached to a mimeograph machine which, after inking, was hand-cranked to produce printed pages. The quality of the finished product was thus affected by the quality and maintenance of two machines, the accuracy and consistency of the typist, the skill of the mimeograph operator, and the age of the mimeograph master – among other influences. At this writing the paper for the early years is yellowing and becoming brittle. It will not last forever; hence the need for an electronic copy.

Western Bird Bander (v.36:2, 1961-v.50:4, 1975) initially continued the same typewriter and mimeograph production process; but graduated to a more advanced printing process with v.41, 1966.

In late fall 2009, the 2700+ pages were hand scanned one side at a time, and saved by volume as Searchable PDF files. The term “searchable” must in this case be considered as an offer of assistance rather than a promise. The optical character recognition (OCR) software was not able to read everything; thus an electronic search brings imperfect results. File sizes range from 2.5 to 12 megabytes per volume, with the inclusion of photographs being responsible for the larger files.

To assist researchers in locating desired information, I have created a searchable Table of Contents for the entire 50 volumes. Where possible, I used existing tables of contents - incorporating all the idiosyncrasies of previous editors, and occasionally *but not consistently* adding potentially useful attributions. I hope to have erred on the side of too much information rather than too little!

I am indebted to the staff of the Occidental College Library who graciously provided electronic copies of three issues missing from the archival set held by WBBA's Editor.
